Crataegus douglasii black hawthorn



can hybridize with other ornamental hawthorn species, creating intermediate characteristics

berries are dark purple to black

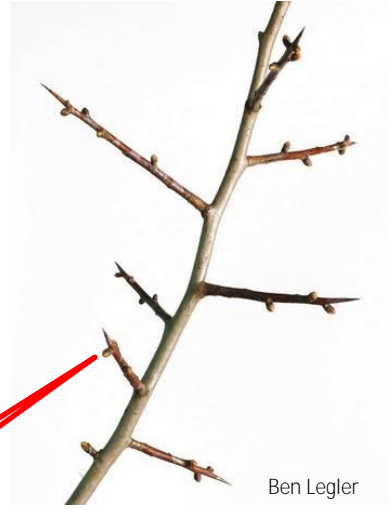
leaves have 3 – 7 lobes and look like mittens

thorns continue to grow as short, thorn tipped branches

armed with straight thorns 1 – 2 cm long
